**Nor'wester Readers Canine Assisted
Learning Program** uses registered therapy dogs to
enhance the educational environment so that children are
motivated to work on their reading, writing, and commu-
nication skills. In addition, our therapy dogs are also
working with school guidance counselors and psycholo-
gists to support students with social and emotional needs.

Therapy dog handlers/volunteers work with stu-
dents individually or in small groups under the direction
and supervision of the classroom teacher. The handler is a
skilled facilitator, shifting performance pressure off the
child and providing support as the child receives super-
vised reading practice necessary to build vocabulary, in-
crease comprehension, and gain fluency as a reader. Un-
motivated readers and learners gain motivation, confi-
dence, and discover the joys of becoming a life-long reader
and learner at the side of their therapy dog.



WALK REGULATIONS:

ONE dog per person only
Dogs must be up to date on all vaccinations
Owners must clean up after their dog
Aggressive dogs should be left at home
We reserve the right to turn away dogs
Owners must be in control of their dog at all times
NO RETRACTIBLE LEASHES or leashes over 6 feet

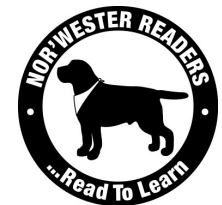
